# Sindh Workers' Welfare Fund (SWWF)

## **Fund Manager Commentary**

During the month under review, the Fund generated a return of 8.5% p.a. against the Benchmark return of 7.6% p.a. However, since its launch in July 2014, the Fund offered an annualized return of 9.3% p.a. against the Benchmark return of 8.1% p.a., hence an out-performance of 1.2% p.a. This out-performance is net of management fee and all other expenses.

NBP Government Securities Savings Fund (NGSSF) invests a minimum of 70% in Government Securities. The Fund invests a minimum 10% of its assets in less than 90 days T-Bills or saving accounts with banks, which enhances liquidity profile of the

As the asset allocation of the Fund shows, exposure in Government Securities was around 70% of the Total Assets and 74% of Net Assets at the end of the month. Last one year allocation in Government Securities was around 74% of net assets. The weighted average time-to-maturity of the Fund is around 0.5 year.

We will rebalance the allocation of the Fund proactively based on the capital market outlook
