Investment Objective
To generate optimal return with minimum risk, to provide easy liquidity and reasonable income to its unit holders by investing primarily in short-term Government Securities.

Fund Manager Commentary
The Fund earned an annualized return of 9.4% p.a. during the month versus the Benchmark return of 9.5% p.a. The return generated by the Fund is net of management fee and all other expenses.

NGSLF's stability rating is 'AAA (f)' awarded by PACRA. The rating reflects exceptionally strong credit and liquidity profile of the Fund. Average daily allocation for the last 365 days in short-term T-Bills was around 86% of net assets. While at the end of the month, T-Bills comprises around 92% of the Total Assets and around 98% of the Net Assets. The weighted average time to maturity of the Fund is 12 days.

We will rebalance the allocation of the Fund proactively based on the capital market outlook.

### Sindh Workers' Welfare Fund (SWWF)

During the month of August 2021, provisioning against Sindh Workers' Welfare Fund by NBP GOVERNMENT SECURITIES LIQUID FUND amounting to Rs. 26.18 million has been reversed on the clarification received by Sindh Revenue Board vide letter No. SRB/TP/70/2013/8772 dated August 12, 2021 addressed to Mutual Funds Association of Pakistan. This reversal of provision has contributed towards an unusual increase in NAV of the NBP GOVERNMENT SECURITIES LIQUID FUND by 1.95% on August 13, 2021. This is one-off event and is not likely to be repeated in the future.
